NORTON INTERNET SECURITY 2002

1. Open your Norton/Symantec security program.
2. Click Options.
3. Click Internet Security (or Personal Firewall).
4. Click Advanced Options.
5. Click the Web tab.
6. Click Add Site.

A new site/domain box appears.

7. Enter the following sites one by one and click OK

- kslc.org
- skyways.org
- elibrary.com
- worldbookonline.com
- worldbook.com
- heritagequestonline.com
- proquest.umi.com

The site names will appear in the left-hand frame of the Advanced Options window, for each of these new sites you have added do the following :

8. Click the name of the new site you just added.
9. Click the Privacy tab.
10. Check the "Use these rules for..." box.
11. Change the Referer from "Block" to "Permit."
12. Change the Cookies from "Block" to "Permit."

Your screen should look something like this:

14. Click Apply, and then click OK.
15. Repeat steps 8-14 for each new site you just added.
16. Click OK to close the Options window.

You should now be able to access the databases from your internet browser. You may need to restart your computer after disabling the software to ensure that the firew all is not in operation.

NORTON INTERNET SECURITY 2003

1. Open your Norton Internet Security or Norton Personal Firewall 2003.
2. Click Options.
3. Click Internet Security (or Personal Firewall).

This step is not always needed

4. Click the Web Content tab.

5. Click Add Site.

A new site/domain box appears.

7. Enter the following sites one by one and click OK

- kslc.org
- skyways.org
- elibrary.com
- worldbookonline.com
- worldbook.com
- heritagequestonline.com
- proquest.umi.com

The site names will appear in the left-hand frame of the Advanced Options window, for each of these new sites you have added do the following :

8. Click the name of the new site you just added. That site name appears in the left frame of the Options window.

8. Click the Global Settings tab.

9. In the "Information about visited sites" section, uncheck "Use default settings."

10. Click Permit

11. Repeat 8-10 for each new site.

12. Click OK to close the Options window.

You should now be able to access the databases from your internet browser. You may need to restart your computer after disabling the software to ensure that the firewall is not in operation.

McAfee Internet Security 5.0

1. Start McAfee Internet Security 5.0.

2. Select Change user settings.

3. Select the Privacy Settings tab.

4. On the Privacy Settings tab uncheck the Enable referer filtering option.

5. Choose Apply.

6. Choose OK.
